Pastor Sam and his team are doing an incredible job reaching Armenians while discipling believers from regional restricted-access nations. I had the opportunity to teach on cross-cultural ministry, gospel contextualization, and the spiritual formation necessary for ministry teams to thrive.

These pioneers inspire me deeply as they minister in challenging environments. While teaching them, I also learn so much from their faith and perseverance.

These studies equip us to better serve and train others to reach Europe and beyond.
